And now a few words from my foster family:

Chloe is a sweet dog, who makes friends almost everywhere she goes. She has recovered very well from her recent bout of IVDD and aside from a small wobble in her step, has rebounded almost seamlessly. She uses ramps well and is happy to be carried up and down stairs. She will try to do stairs herself, so she needs to be supervised. She does not like to be left alone and is on medication for separation anxiety. Even with the medication she barks frequently when her people are gone. She sleeps well in her crate overnight. She has been aggressive with other dogs, so would be best as an 'only dog'. She goes to the door when she needs to go out. She has cataracts and requires good lighting to see, and her hearing may not be what it once was. She's a quirky girl, but she will make a lovely companion.
