#### And now a few words from my foster family:

When people are within sight, he is quite content being in the crate for short periods of time. He sleeps in the crate beside our bed at night and doesn't make a sound until morning when it is time to go outside, at which time he lets out little whimpers. Overall, he is a great little pup and will be a great fit for an active family.
