

We're not very active boys and would rather snuggle on the couch, but we like walking and sniffing around the neighbourhood. We're learning to walk well on a leash and enjoy exploring with our foster family and foster sister.

Titus: I'm a chill guy and mostly like to nap or look out the window. I'm not quite as cuddly as my brother Lincoln, but I love to be next to my people and love pets and belly rubs. I like walks, but as a gentleman of leisure, I only have one speed. I like to stroll on the nature paths near my foster mums' house, but I get tired a lot faster than my brother and sometimes need a ride back.

Lincoln: I love nothing more than snuggling in my human's lap to have a nap. I may have been a cat in my past life, and I'll perch on you no matter what you're doing (sitting on the couch, hanging out outside, working out). Snuggles and belly rubs are my favourite thing. I can be nervous about new things and take some time to warm up to new people or situations, but once I do, I want all the love and attention. I've had some issues with fear-based growling and possessiveness. I'll need a patient family that will make me feel safe and continue my training.

Us: My brother and I both love food. We can't contain our excitement when it's mealtime or there are treats around. We're learning our basic commands but will need some help continuing to learn good manners. We don't like to be left alone and will bark in our crate if you leave, so an apartment might not be suitable for us. We would do best in a home where our people are around most of the time. We are excellent home office companions though and we quietly curl up in our bed while our foster mum works. We get along with most dogs, but we're more interested in our people. We're okay with the two resident cats but will chase them occasionally!

AND NOW A FEW WORDS FROM OUR FOSTER FAMILY...

Titus and Lincoln are very sweet and cuddly boys. They are very bonded and spend most of their time snuggled up together. Lincoln can be nervous of new things and will occasionally bark when something is unfamiliar or growl if something is scary. Titus will help because that's what brothers are for. Lincoln is also a sensitive guy and does best with clear boundaries and a calm environment. Lincoln is a bit more reserved, preferring not to run to strangers to be petted, whereas Titus wants affection from anyone and everyone. They would do best as the only dogs in the home, as Lincoln can get grumpy with other dogs in his space. He has also had some issues with guarding his bed and his people. He will sometimes growl at Titus or another person if they encroach on his space or try to pet him when he is relaxing. Titus has lost a lot of weight since coming into foster care, but his weight will need to be monitored in his new home. He has had IVDD episodes in the past that were treated with medication, so it will be very important to not allow him to jump on and off furniture and he will need to be carried up and down stairs. They will need a family that is committed to walking them regularly and working on maintaining their weight, but they don't need a lot of activity to be happy. Titus and Lincoln are housetrained when on a regular routine and will not soil in their crate. Lincoln will pee if he is scared or startled though. This doesn't happen very often, but he would do best in a quiet home with a consistent schedule. They would also do best in a home where someone is home most of the time, as they don't like being left alone. They are getting much better with this, but an apartment wouldn't be good for them. These boys are tiny little love bugs! They give kisses and tail wags, are very snuggly, and love to cuddle up with their favourite people (preferably with a blanket or two for burrowing). With the right rules and boundaries, particularly to make sure that Lincoln does not think he needs to look out for himself and his brother, they are amazing boys and will be a wonderful addition to their forever family.
